Track upgrades at Reedy Creek

In October 2024 Parks Victoria closed several informal tracks at Reedy Creek in Chiltern-Mount Pilot National Park. The tracks were not being maintained by Parks Victoria as they were not part of the formal track network. Many of the tracks were duplicates that ran parallel to each other that went to the same location on the creek.

Upgrading and reopening tracks

In response to the community concerns raised about the track closures, Parks Victoria is now in the process of upgrading and reopening five tracks. These works will improve visitor access to popular camping areas on Reedy Creek. The works will include new drainage lines, sheeting and grading of the track surface and new signage. Parks Victoria is also undertaking hazardous tree assessments where tracks are being reopened to popular campsites.

Parks Victoria has commenced the process to engage a contractor to commence the works in February 2025 and it is anticipated the works pending weather conditions will be completed by the end of March 2025.

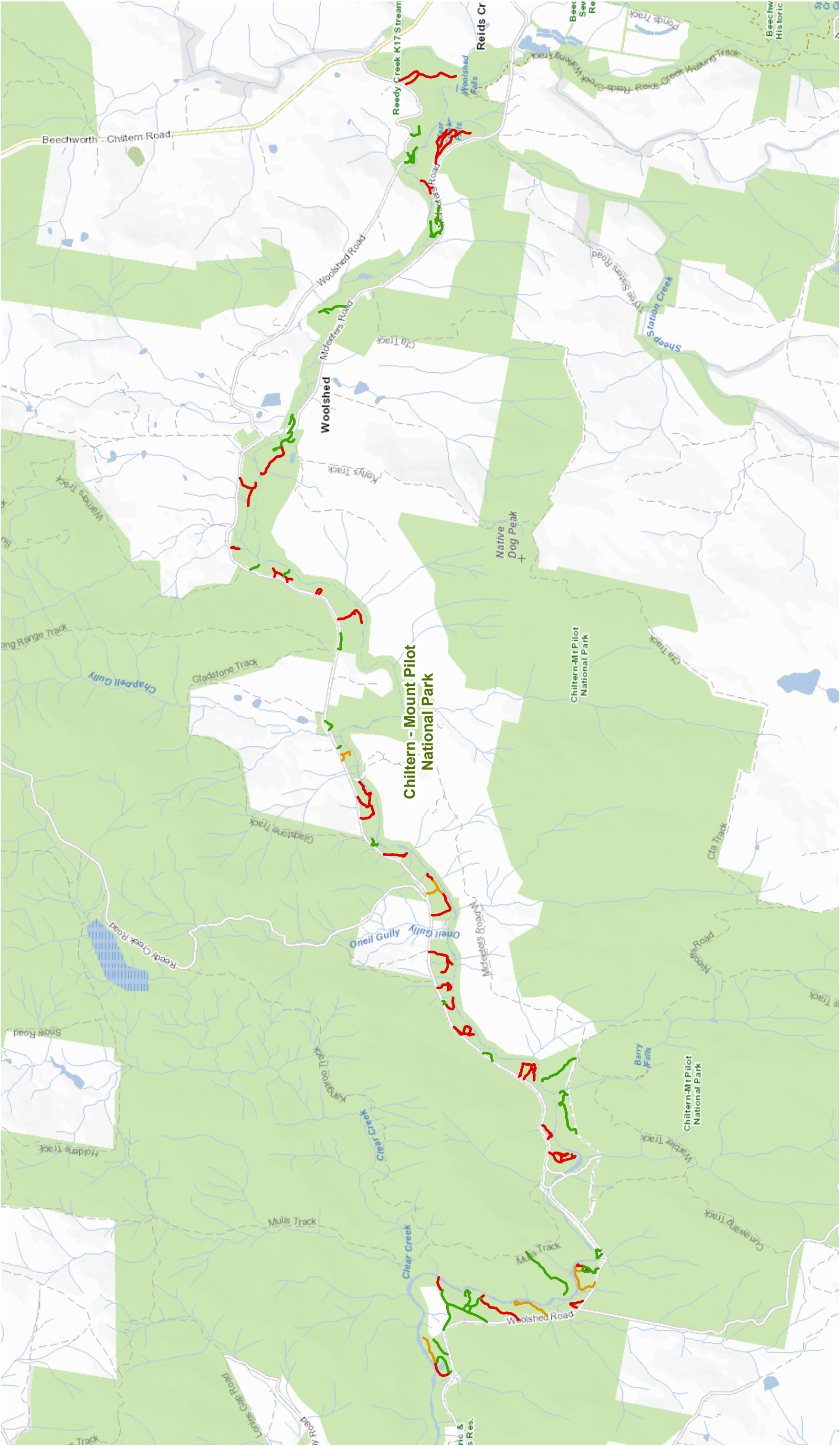
Several tracks will remain closed and will have signage in place asking park visitors to not use the track and instead use the tracks that have been upgraded to access Reedy Creek.
